SCHEDULE INFORMATION First week of school

Schedule Tips

Wait! What are collab days and block schedules?

- Block schedule "A" (1st, 3rd, 5th) or "B" (2nd, 4th, 6th) days - 100 minute classes (plus 0 and 7th every day)
- Minimum Day schedule All classes meet but for shorter periods 30 minutes each.
- Collaboration Days-Wednesday All classes, but class periods are 40 minutes and school ends early for teacher collaboration (department meetings, teacher training, etc.)




- Schedule physical exam and have form filled out by doctor. Physicals are good for exactly one CALENDAR year.
